Tigard High School, OR—The Rams got their second win of the season today behind a strong start on the mound from Senior Jacob Ley and a solid team effort offensively. Ley threw 4 innings of 1-hit ball giving up just one run when Century manufactured a run after a misplayed fielder's choice by the Rams. Louis Ceciliani and Casey Minnick combined in relief to close out the game.

Joe Farrell drove in Bryce McKinney in the first with a double down the right field line following a two-out, none on base error by the Jaguars. Max Virnig and Farrell then scored on Jaguar errors to make the early score 3 to 0. The Rams got three more in the second inning when Ryan Matheny's two-out infield single was followed by a Jacob Ley single to right, a 2 RBI McKinney single to right, and a Max Virnig RBI triple. Virnig would add another RBI triple into Tigard Stadiums very deep right center gap later in the game. Joe Farrell made the score 9-1 in the fourth inning with a 2 run home run that just scraped its way over the fence a mere 273 feet down the right field line.

The offensive heat stayed on late as 11 players finished the game with at least one hit and ten different Rams scored. Ryan Ecalbarger played a solid game at shortstop and recorded his first base hit of the season. Joe Marziello, Casey Minnick, Louis Ceciliani, Sedrik Taylor-Revis, and Ryan Matheny also got their first hits on the year.
